

TRAINING EQUIVALENCY

Girl Guides of Canada recognizes the wealth of skills and experience members bring to the organization. We encourage you to apply for equivalency for GGC National training modules if you feel you have prior similar training or equivalent experience.

Guiders wishing to request equivalency should complete a **TR.1 Request for Equivalency** form (available on Member Zone) stating which module(s) they are seeking equivalency for and providing evidence of knowledge or skills equivalent to all the learning objectives for the module(s). Do not hesitate to contact a Trainer or Training Adviser for assistance in identifying the learning objectives for each module.

The completed TR.1 form and any supplementary information should be forwarded for consideration to the Provincial Training Adviser at bc-training@girlguides.ca.

*If the equivalency request is for any of the modules in the Outdoor Activity Leadership (**OAL**) **Foundation** or **Tent Camping** modules, the appropriate BC OAL Equivalency Request form must accompany the TR.1 form.

Applicants should be aware that they may be contacted for further information or to discuss their qualifications, and that the granting of equivalency is not automatic.

Trainers and Training Advisers are available to answer any additional questions that Guiders might have about this process

NOTES:

- Equivalency is not applicable where similar and/or related training has been taken within Guiding. For example, a Guider who has completed and received credit in iMIS for OAL Trail would not be granted equivalency for OAL-2 Tent Camping.
- 2. No training recognition pin can be awarded where an equivalency has been granted for one or more modules forming part of the training pathway or stream.
