3. How was our name decided?
4. Before we became Lagimodiere Area, what Area were we part of?
5. How many districts make up our Area? Name them.
6. Out of our current districts which were part of Lagimodiere Area 25 years ago? Which ones came later and when?

## Where are we?

1. Find our boundaries (roughly) on a map. How does it differ from 25 yrs ago?
2. Name 2 cities/towns other than Winnipeg that are in Lagimodiere Area.
3. Where is our Area office located? Where has it been in the past? What is our phone number?
4. Where do you (we) fit it to the World Assoc. of Girl Guides and Girl Scouts? Draw a chart showing all levels from the girl/woman to WAGGGS.
