

## How Do I Get My Training Recognition Pin?

We know that pins are important to Guiders!

We also know that the TR.9 Training Module Tracking form and the information on Member Zone both say to contact your Provincial Training Adviser about receiving training recognition pins – but that is because the process is different in every province. Here in BC, training recognition pins are usually handled at the Area level, unless it is a provincial training.

- 1. We recommend that you **reach out to your District Commissioner first**, and ask how the awarding of training recognition pins is handled in your Area. For one thing, your DC will want to know that you have taken training!
- 2. If your DC is not the person who can get the pin for you, your next step may be to contact your **Area Training Adviser**, and if you're not sure who that is, the list of current Area Training Advisers can be found <u>here</u>
