### OTHER DETAILS

- The Council will have a minimum of two (2) face-to-face meetings per year, one (1) of which will be in combination with a Board of Directors meeting.
- Other meetings as needed may be scheduled through teleconference or digital formats.
- Term is one (1) year, renewable for one (1) consecutive year while the Council member continues to be an active girl member.
- Council consists of nine (9) Ranger girl members, one from each Provincial Council jurisdiction.

We invite Rangers who represent our diverse communities across Canada to apply – as we are looking for the Council to reflect Canada's vast diversity.

\* Pathfinders eligible to become Rangers in the next Guiding year may apply to join the Council during the spring recruitment process, and, if selected, assume their role in the fall of the same year as registered first year Rangers.
