Girl Engagement Coordinator

Are you interested in camping, international travel and Girls First program, then this position is for you? It oversees all three of these committees and represents them on Provincial Council. You would also work closely with the Youth Forum Coordinator to make sure the youth voice is heard. Leadership and communication skills would be an asset for the Girl Engagement position.

Risk and Compliance Coordinator

Are you a "safety first" kind of person, then you would enjoy this position? Identifying risks and establishing mitigation plans would be a big part of this job. You would oversee and give direction to the Provincial Safe Guide Adviser and would also sit on Provincial Council. Critical thinking and decision-making skills would be needed for the Risk and Compliance position.

Provincial Training Adviser

Training, training, training, what could be more important than making sure all Guiders have the knowledge and ability to present the best program for the girls. You would be coordinating training events for Guiders as well as other trainers. This position would report to the Member Services Coordinator and work closely with the Communications and Membership Advisers. Good communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to work with a team are essential for the Training Adviser.

Youth Forum Coordinator

Are you a strong believer that girls should have a voice on issues of programming, events and membership growth plans? Could you work closely with the Youth Forum and stay current on issues and trends impacting girls of today and take it to the Provincial Council table? Sound like a fun and fulfilling position? If so, Youth Forum Coordinator is for you. Leadership skills would be essential as well as good communication and listening ability.

Provincial Awards Activity (vacant now)

If you have some free time and enjoy working alone at your convenience, then Provincial Awards is perfect for you. You would be composing letters that would be read out when a Guider is presented with any of the Provincial Awards. Writing skills and the ability to meet deadlines would be important.
