

Application for Newfoundland and Labrador provincial Ranger award

The recipient of the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Ranger Award is a youth member who has learned from experience, has grown with their peers and Guiders and has become a leader. They represent the many youth in Guiding who provide leadership and inspiration to others and who will be future leaders in their communities.

Award Criteria

Girl Guides of Canada, Newfoundland and Labrador Council has developed the following criteria to recognize the efforts of an outstanding youth member of the organization.

This award will be given to a member who:

- has lived in Newfoundland and Labrador for a period of not less than two years
- has been a member of Guiding for at least three years, not necessarily consecutive
- is currently registered as a Ranger

The nominee will have many of the following characteristics:

- Shows leadership among their peers and in the community
- Acts as a role model for their peers and for younger girls
- Actively provides service in their community
- Lives by the Guiding Promise and Law

Nominator

The following are required to complete the application:

- Nomination form to be completed by the nominating Guider.
- Recommendation form

-two separate recommendations from active members of Guiding who are not related to the nominee

-one recommendation from an adult not presently involved in Guiding and not related to the nominee



Nomination Process

CONFIDENTIALITY: Nominations are to be kept confidential from the nominee.

The nominating Guider should provide the online recommendation form to the three references. The award criteria is included on the recommendation form. Any information provided will be kept strictly confidential.

Award Presentation

The NL Provincial Ranger Award will be presented annually at the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Council year-end meeting and celebration.
