Summer Kwah-ee is a 5 night camp for youth who are registered as Guides at the time of registration. No experience necessary. Additional information including camp fee and location of camp can be found on the youth application.

Please note:

- Youth apply individually and will be assigned a patrol before camp.
- The patrols are made up of 6 guides with 2 rangers/pathfinders as patrol leaders.
- All campers sleep in a tent with 3 to 5 other guides.
- This is an outdoor camp and therefore activities will be done outdoors.
- All campers will be using outhouses (lats) and outside washing stations for cleanup.
- Meals will be prepared by the camp quartermasters/cooks and guides, do not send food unless discussed with camp staff before camp.
- Guides will help with all chores, including helping with meals, washing dishes, keeping the outhouses (lats) clean, and keeping the property clean.
- Kit list and other information, including activities, will be emailed before camp
- No Electronics at camp The tents do not have electricity for recharging and electronics are expensive and could get lost or damaged at camp. If there is a reason why a youth must have electronics, then they will be left with the adult staff unless needed
