

Provincial Archives Sub-committee Role and Responsibilities

ROLE

- To maintain and preserve the records and artifacts of Ontario Council
- To make records, historical information and artifacts accessible as resources to explore and learn about the Guiding movement and its impact on communities throughout Ontario and Nunavut
- To carry out any additional work as directed by the Provincial Council
- To consult with other committees in order to combine the expertise of all for the benefit of Guiding in Ontario and Nunavut

MEMBERS

Membership shall include:

- Archives Adviser (Chair)
- Members at large (2-4)
- Youth Member at large (1-2)

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Provincial Archives Specialty Community shall:

- 1. Record and catalogue activities and events
- 2. Preserve and store historically significant items
- 3. Ensure records regarding Archives holdings are current and up-to-date
- 4. Provide historical documentation and information
- 5. Support the historical research enquiries of all Guiding Members
- 6. Work to share Ontario's collection with Guiding members in Ontario and Nunavut, including exploring new ways to engage Guiding members
- 7. Report on activities and provide recommendations, via the Chair, to Council in a tabled report
