

## Provincial Program Sub-committee Role and Responsibilities

## **ROLE**

- To support and promote all learning and engagement activities relating to branchspecific programming activities for girls
- To develop provincial program initiatives (i.e. challenges) and events for youth Members in Ontario and Nunavut Guiding
- To carry out any additional work as directed by the Provincial Council
- To consult with other committees in order to combine the expertise of all for the benefit of Guiding in Ontario and Nunavut

## **MEMBERS**

Membership shall include:

- Provincial Program Adviser (Chair)
- Members at large (2-4)
- Youth Members at large (1-2)
- Provincial Public Relations/Communications Adviser (ad hoc)
- Provincial Membership Registration and Retention Adviser (ad hoc)

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

The Provincial Program Committee shall:

- 1. Develop provincial initiatives, such as Challenges, for youth Members and Units, as well as support the implementation of these opportunities
- 2. Plan and organize provincial virtual and/or in-person events for youth Members, as directed by Provincial Council
- 3. Explore and promote new and creative ways of enhancing, enriching, and presenting girl programs
- 4. Contribute to the advancement and understanding of GGC programming within Ontario and Nunavut, including Girls First
- 5. Report on activities, via the Chair, to Council in the Girl Engagement Coordinator's usual tabled report
