Instant Meeting Camping Ambassador

Age/Group: Sparks and Brownies

Program Duration: 1 h

We hope that you will consider joining us for one of our many programs.

Have girls introduce themselves and ask them to share a one word answer to what they like to do outside.

Body Of Activity

Instructions and Activities

Huckle buckle with camp activities, mingle or molecule tag. The group mingles and then you call out atoms or a certain number. Each group then forms a shape/activity that you call out

- Canoeing
- Campfire
- Tent
- Star Gazing
- Hiking
- Swimming
- Roasting a Marshmallow
- Archery
- Rock Climbing
- Sailing



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Natural picture frames

Have each girl draw a picture of themselves doing a camp activity that they have always wanted to try.

Take the group on a neighbourhood walk or outside (if weather permits) to find things to frame their pictures with. Good examples are pine needles, leaves and twigs.

The girls can then place these natural items around the picture and with the help of an adult glue them on to frame their picture. A hot glue gun works best if there are adults who can assist the girls with them.

Make Tableau "Pictures" of all the Camping activities used in the Huckle Buckle game.
