












The PC Challenge: June

Extended Criteria:

- Can be awarded more than once (one for every provincial committee/event planned);

 meeting with a report of what she has accomplished, what she plans to do next and suggestions for
 additions and changes;

Mid-Year Reviews

With the Guiding year winding to a close, most of us are looking forward to a break from the books over the summer. Now is the time to start preparing for midyear reviews. Preparing the mid-year reviews now will give you some piece of mind over the summer that all items have been recorded and the books balanced. It will make for a smoother transition come the fall when the Guiding year starts up again.

Reminders for the mid-year reviews:

- Period covered (all): should be from January 1st, 2019 to when your unit/district/council "ended" in the Spring.
- Unit & Trefoil Guild Books: to be reviewed by District Treasurers. Completed Annual Financial Reports and Financial Review Checklists to be sent to the office.
- District Books: either (1) have books reviewed by another District Treasurer and send the Annual Financial Report and completed Financial Review Checklist to the office, or (2) send books and all supporting documentation to the office, where a reviewer will be found.
- Reports to be submitted to the office as soon as possible, latest being the end of June.

Once the reviews are complete, you may continue where you left off until the end of the year. Keep in mind that for the year-end review, it is the full 2019 being reviewed, so all documents from the mid-year must still be retained and re-submitted.

For Units and Districts where the treasurer is changing over the summer, a full independent review must be done now.

NEW: Unit and district budgets should cover September-August.

Ticks

You may have heard the on news recently that the incidents of ticks with Lyme disease are spreading across the country. It is especially important that we, as supervisors of children, are current about precautions, checking for the presence of ticks and proper removal. The main points are:

- Wear insect repellant with DEET
- Wear long pants, long-sleeved shirt, socks and shoes. Tuck pants into socks and tuck shirt into pants
- Examine your clothing and entire body after activity in the woods
- Remove any ticks following instructions
- Consult a doctor if there are symptoms
