**Cynthia O'Connor Scholarship**

- Funds Available:** One scholarship of \$250.00 will be awarded annually. The Cynthia O'Connor Scholarship is a onetime scholarship. Applicants can apply for both scholarships but can only receive one in a year. Applicants may only receive each scholarship once in a lifetime.
- Who may apply:** Anyone who has been an active Member of Girl Guides for at least two years.
- Criteria:**
- Individuals must be a current Girl Guides of Canada Member.
  - Enrolled at any post-secondary institution, no less than 60% of full time.
  - Applicants must be between 17-25 years of age.
  - Applicants may apply and receive the scholarship only once.
  - Unsuccessful candidates may apply again.
  - Priority will be given to applicants with a strong background in Guiding and community involvement.
  - The selection committee uses a marking scale that reflects the level of activity a girl/woman has with regard to service, camping, etc., and is also looking for creativity in the "What Guiding Means to Me" statement. The committee looks forward to reviewing the applications each year and is always impressed with the involvement of the applicants in their community.
