Label one end of the room peace makers and the other end peace breakers.</p> <p>Have the girls stand in the middle of the room and yell out attributes for both peace makers and peace breakers. If you yell out share your toys the girls would run to peace makers. If you yell out doesn't help a friend they would run to the peace breaker side. Here is a list to get you started. 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Game	<p>Tug of Peace</p> <p>You'll need: skipping ropes</p> <p>This game will have the girls working together. Put them in small groups and together use the skipping ropes to form a picture. they can make a triangle, a circle, numbers, a face, bunny ears or whatever you can think of. The idea is for them to work together.</p>
