Gathering Activity	Print off the camping colouring page and have the girls colour in their circle corners till everyone arrives	
Opening		
Game	<p>Dressing Properly Relay</p> <p>You'll need: sets of clothing for each team you will have. Each set of clothes should have summer and winter gear including footwear</p> <p>Have the girls split up into teams and line up in relay fashion. On go they will run down to the end where the clothes are put on a piece of the clothing and run back. When the first girl gets back to her team the next member goes.</p> <p>Once the team has all their clothes they will sort them into the proper seasons. First team done wins.</p> <p>This game will give you a chance to talk about proper clothes for camp. Example- no tank tops or sandals and then talk about why these are safety issues</p>	Key to Camping- Dress Right
Activity	<p>Mini S'mores</p> <p>You'll need: tea light candles, graham square cereal, chocolate chips, mini marshmallows, toothpicks</p> <p>Light the candles and place a marshmallow on a toothpick and begin to roast your marshmallow. Once it is ready place marshmallow in between two pieces of cereal and add a chocolate chip.</p> <p>This is a fun activity and will give you a chance to talk about campfire safety for when you get to camp.</p>	
Craft	<p>Clay Decorated Cutlery</p> <p>From: http://guidersunshine.wordpress.com/category/crafts/</p> <p>You'll need: (for 20 girls):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -20 knives, 20 forks, and 20 spoons – I found mine at Walmart, there were packs of 4 for \$1, so I spent \$15 on this (75 cents per girl). You could also ask parents to bring randoms from home that they don't need anymore. -7 packages of different colours of modelling clay to bake such as Sculpey or Fimo – I found mine at Michaels which were \$3.49 a package, but if you wait until they are on sale, or use 40% off coupons, they can be much cheaper! (depending on your price 	Part of Super Craft

can be 75 cents to \$1.25 per girl)

Total cost of craft = \$1.50 to \$2 per girl

Total time for craft = 5 minutes prep, 15 to 30 minutes with the girls, 15 minutes to bake



1. Cut your clay into small pieces. You should be able to get at least 12 pieces per package. A little goes a long way! We allowed the girls to choose 2 pieces of different colours per utensil.

2. Warm the clay up in your hands. Once it is warm enough, you should be able to mold it around the bottom of your utensil and make unique designs. I prefer the Sculpey brand to use with the Sparks, as it warmed up quickly in their hands (I found FiKmo takes longer to warm up).

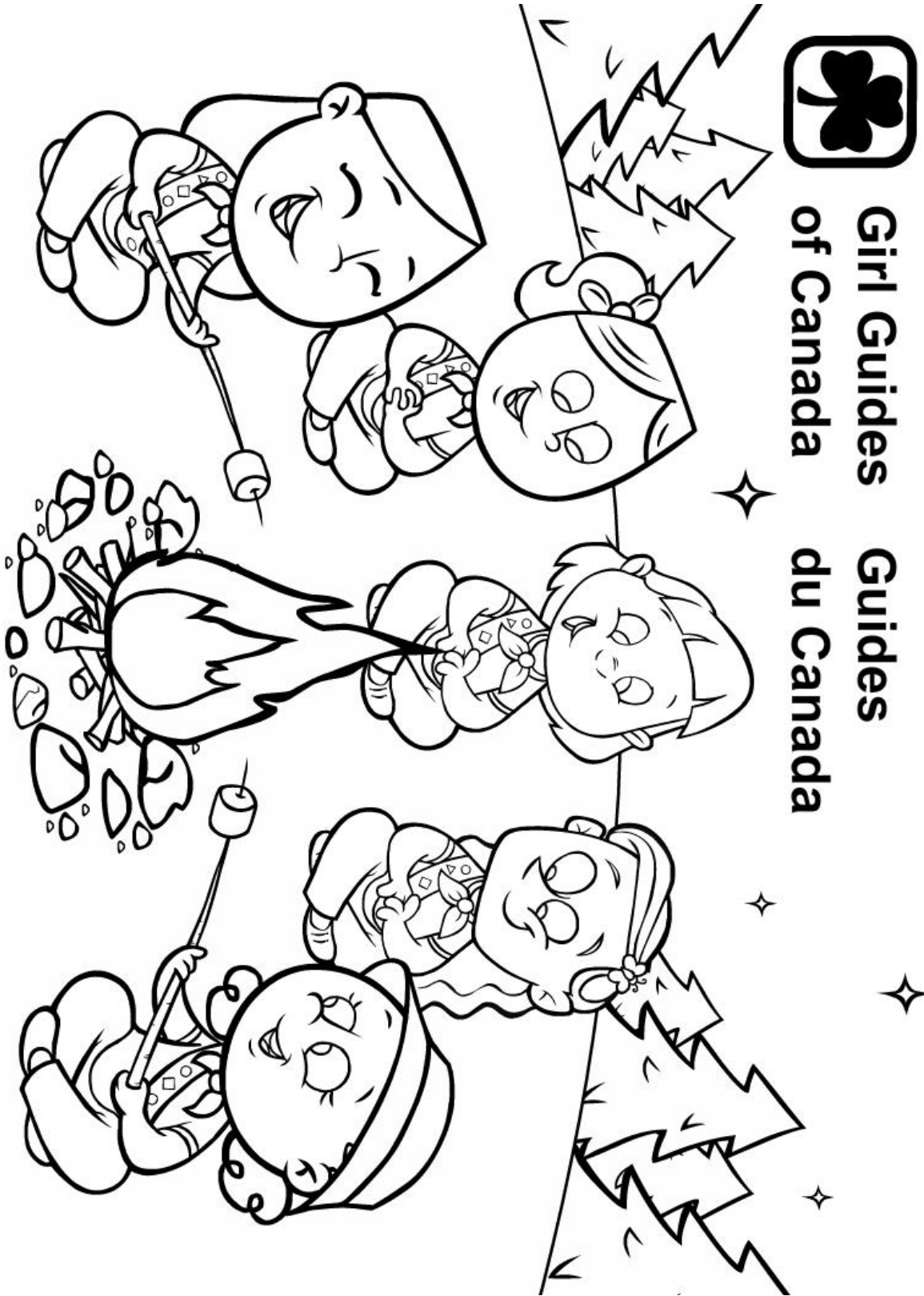


3. Place cutlery on a cookie sheet. Bake according to directions. Mine said 275 degrees Fahrenheit for 15 minutes. Don't have an oven at your meeting place? Take scraps of paper with girls' names and elastic band their utensils and names together and bake when you get home.

4. Let cool and with a permanent marker, on the back of each utensil, write the girls initials. Most of my girls used pink and purple clay so they all look very similar.

5. Enjoy your new cutlery at your next sleepover or camp
