Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada 2012 Norma Osler Education Scholarship

**For registered Members of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada
pursuing a post-secondary degree with particular emphasis in the field of education
(including teachers' college)**

The National Scholarship Program is one of the ways that Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada (GGC) recognizes Members who embody the Mission and Values of the organization. This program supports Members to remain in Guiding while they pursue their education/training at a recognized post-secondary institution

APPLICATION CRITERIA

1. This scholarship is awarded to currently registered Members.
2. This scholarship is conditional on acceptance/continuation in a full-time program in education (including teachers' college) at a recognized post-secondary institution.
 - a. This scholarship will be awarded to a student who plans on working with youth upon completion of their post-secondary degree.
 - b. This scholarship will also be available to Members pursuing degrees in history or English.
 - c. Recognized post-secondary institutions include universities, colleges and vocational schools where high school completion is the normal entrance requirement.
3. The successful applicant plans to continue to be an on-going Member of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada.
4. Due to the number of applicants, materials submitted as part of the application process (e.g. essays, transcripts) cannot be returned.
5. Scholarship recipients will be informed in June and unsuccessful applicants will be notified in July.
6. Successful scholarship recipients must agree to be profiled in GGC materials such as news releases, *Canadian Guider* articles, and on girlguides.ca in order to help promote Guiding and our scholarship program.
7. While Members can apply for more than one GGC scholarship (i.e. Dr. Roberta Bondar Scholarship, Col. Karen Ritchie Scholarship, etc.), they will only be awarded one scholarship. In addition, while former recipients will not be awarded another scholarship, non-recipients (unsuccessful applicants) can apply every year, until they receive a scholarship.

APPLICATION DEADLINE: APRIL 1, 2012

NOTE: Faxed and e-mailed applications will not be accepted

INSTRUCTIONS AND HELPFUL HINTS

- **REVIEW THE 2012 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDE**
- Type your application using size 12 font (please do not hand write).
- Do not attach additional pages. They will not be read.
- Take your time. Don't rush and do not leave any sections unanswered.
- Provide specific examples. Screeners can only give you points for the information you include in your application. Use your space wisely.
- Remember that the screeners are from across Canada and may not be familiar with local and regional activities, camps and events that you participated in. You may need to provide a short explanation and/or define acronyms.
- What are we looking for in your Statement on Guiding?
 - This is where you can let us know what being a Member has meant to you. We are looking for honesty and your personal connection to Guiding.
 - Elaborate on or describe (points are awarded for each of these):
 - The role that Guiding has played in your life.
 - How Guiding has assisted with your personal growth.
 - What Guiding has offered that you couldn't find anywhere else.
 - How your Guiding knowledge and experiences have impacted others around you.
 - Work with a friend to ensure that your message comes across to your reader in the way that you intended.
 - BE CREATIVE – This is about YOU! Let your personality shine through.
 - Make a draft of your Statement on Guiding early and keep on editing it until you are satisfied with it.
- Before mailing in your application package, please check to ensure that you have answered the following:
 - Did you use the current year's application form?
 - Did you proofread your application including spelling and grammar? Points can be deducted for poor presentation.
 - Did you have someone proofread your application and offer feedback?
 - Did you sign your application form?
 - Did you include your transcript(s)?
