



Multi-Coloured Crayons

MATERIALS:

- Bits/broken pieces of crayons
- Silicone muffin mould
- Oven
- Paper for drawing

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.** Remove all the paper from the crayon bits.
- 2.** Choose a handful of crayons. Use a variety of colours for a rainbow effect.
- 3.** Put the crayons into a silicone muffin mold (so they don't stick).
Option: mix the colours or layer them in a pattern to achieve a unique blend.
- 4.** Melt them in the oven on low temperature.
- 5.** Let cool. Draw with your amazing new multi-coloured crayon!
