



DREAM BANNER

This is a great craft that inspires *Girl Greatness*! Girls can create any inspirational image on the banner and hang it over their bed. Now that makes for good night dreams! These instructions were modified from the original posted on The Learning Chanel (TLC) website, as part of their Sewing Crafts* section.

MATERIALS:

- 36x48-inch piece of felt
- Fabric glue and scissors
- Two 36-inch wood dowels with 1/2-inch diameter
OR sticks clear of twigs and relatively straight
- 4 large wood beads or other material for decoration
- Fabric and felt scraps
- Yarn or string

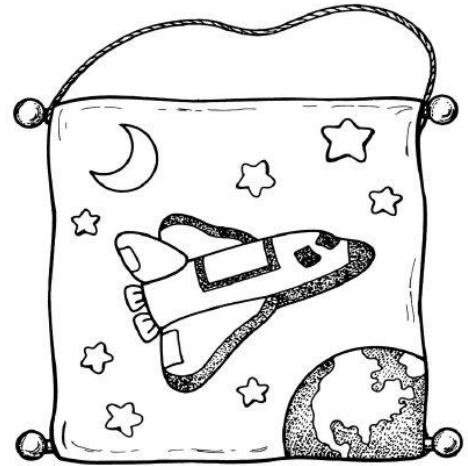

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut pieces of fabric and felt to make a picture of your inspirational dream! As you work, place them down on your fabric to establish your layout.

2. Apply a thin film of glue on the back of your cutout shapes. Glue them down by pressing firmly. Note: You may need to let this sit and dry before moving on to the next step.

3. Fold down the top and bottom ends of the felt picture, by about 2 inches. This will form the dowel/stick pockets. Glue each end down. Set aside to dry.

4. Tie a piece of yarn or string to the ends of the top dowel. Glue beads on the ends of the dowel to complete your dream banner!
