



## Easy Stained Glass Paper Art

This great craft was posted on Shannon Bertels' "acraftymom" blog\*. It's fun, easy, and looks fabulous on dreary, cold windows!

### MATERIALS:

- Wax crayons (must be wax)
- Small bowl with vegetable oil
- Cotton balls or Cotton pads
- 8.5 x 11 plain white paper

### INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.** Draw your picture or design with the crayons on your paper.
- 2.** Ensure you're your white paper is completely covered in colour.
- 3.** Dip your cotton ball or cotton pad into the vegetable oil.
- 4.** Rub the oil over your picture, until the entire paper is saturated.
- 5.** Hang the oily paper to dry for a good 12 hours.
- 6.** The oil created a "see through" effect, making the coloured paper look like real stained glass! Hang in a window for everyone to see!
