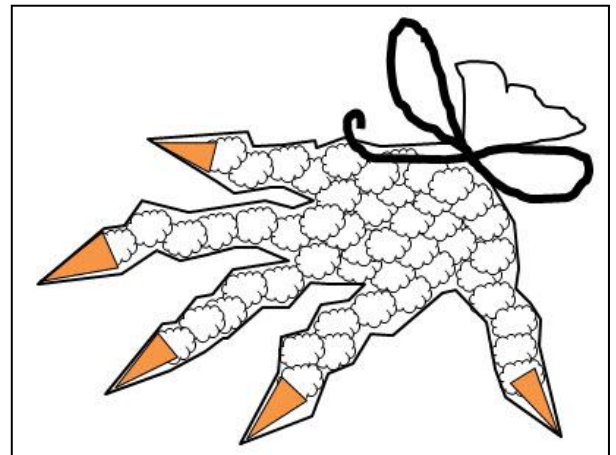


HALLOWEEN POPCORN HANDS

Halloween is lots of fun and here is a simple craft that anyone can do if planning a Unit party or a haunted house. The best part is that the popcorn can be eaten once the party is over!

MATERIALS:

- Clear non-latex surgical gloves
- Popped Popcorn
- Candy corn (or other candy shaped like a triangle, or fingernail)
- Colourful ribbon or elastic bands
- Any small Halloween decoration such as a black spider, a cobweb, a fun ring
- Option: Glue & Scissors



INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.** Make one small incision with your scissors at the tips of each finger, for both gloves.
Note: Make the incision just big enough for the Candy Corn to fit through, but not fall through. Alternatively, simply glue the Candy Corn onto the tip of the gloves.
- 2.** Fill the glove with the popped popcorn so that every finger is full.
- 3.** Tie the end of the glove with a colourful ribbon or seal it using an elastic band.
- 4.** Put the ring on one of the fingers.

Put these gloves somewhere spooky, like beside a popcorn bowl!
