Game	Catch a story Have a beanbag. Begin a story. Throw it to someone who then must continue the story. This will make it easy for shy girls to get rid of her turn quickly. A variation of this game is fortunately/ unfortunately. Each person must add a sentence, changing between fortunately and unfortunately. Example: Unfortunately guides got cancelled this week. Fortunately there was another meeting across town we could go to. Unfortunately the car was broke and in the shop. Fortunately the hot air balloon was ready to go.	
Game	Sound Effects Two players stand up. One person acts out an ordinary everyday activity (such as brushing his teeth) to pantomime. The second person makes sound effects to accompany the scene! Then two more players take a turn.	
Production	Guiding Video Work in small groups and make a short video about what Guiding is about to you. Work together to come up with a script, how it should be shot, how long it should be and what you want the message to be. Use your cell phones, ipods or whatever else is available.
