

## CWFF Bank

The 84<sup>th</sup> Sparks in Calgary made banks in early January to collect all of their CWFF money in. We went from \$1.00 per girl to an average of \$10.00 per girl. WOW!



To make a bank you will need for each girl:

- 1 soup can
- Fun Foam
- Leatherette
- Large elastic
- Decorate when finished with stickers, fun foam or other materials
- Ribbon

### To make the bank

1. Reparation before the meeting:

- Trace a circle using the soup can.
- Cut fun foam to cover around the side of the can. Glue it on with a hot glue gun.
- Cut a slit in the leatherette

## 2. Girls can do at the meeting:

- The girls push the circle inside to the bottom of the can
- Decorate the side of the can with stickers
- Have the girls hold on the leatherette while a leader places an elastic around to hold it on (be sure it is on tight)
- Tie a ribbon around to hide the elastic.
- Send home note for parents (below) to explain.
