

How the Overnight 1 Stage applies to facilities in Calgary Area as of Nov. 18, 2021

As of November 18, Return to In-Person Guiding (RIPG) for Overnight 1 allows Pathfinders, Rangers and adults to share accommodations during overnight activities. This handout explains how the new rules affect overnight capacities and rates for facilities in Calgary Area. Guiders must refer to the RIPG document for full requirements on overnight activities.

Sleeping Indoors at Camp Jubilee (Guides)

RIPG Overnight 1 Stage requires Guides to sleep in single accommodation only. They can't share rooms unless they live in the same household. This means that Camp Jubilee indoor sites are not practical for overnight use by Guide-aged girls.

Sleeping Indoors at Camp Jubilee (Pathfinders, Rangers and Adults)

RIPG Overnight 1 Stage allows Pathfinders, Rangers and Adults to sleep in shared accommodation with maximum 8 people per room. Maximum one unit per site.

Okay to use spare mattresses from the bunk rooms as long as you clean them afterwards. | \$50 booking fee + \$396.50 site fee |
| Pallesen | 16 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> max 8 people in bunks upstairs (normally 40 bunks). The bunk rooms in Pallesen do not have doors so the RIPG rules consider the entire upstairs to be a single bunk room. max 8 people on floor in activity room downstairs. Must bring own mattresses. Don't haul mattresses from the bunks upstairs. | \$50 booking fee + \$332.50 site fee |
| Namiyi | 10 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 8 people in main bunk room (normally 18 bunks available) 2 people in side bunk room (normally 4 bunks available) | \$50 booking fee + \$175.00 site fee |
| Rabbit | 8 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> max 8 people in bunks (normally 10 bunks available) | \$50 booking fee + \$150 site fee |
| Stan's Cottage | 4 | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 2 single beds + 2 bunks (normally 4 bunks available) | \$50 booking fee + \$75.00 site fee |



Sleeping in Tents at Camp Jubilee (Guides, Pathfinders, Rangers and Adults)

Sleeping Indoors at the Guide Centre (Guides, Pathfinders, Rangers and Adults)

The Calgary Guide Centre offers many options for overnight use for Guides, Pathfinders, Rangers and adults. It has a full kitchen, plus 2 large rooms and 8 small rooms, all of which have doors, that can be used for sleeping. Different room configurations can accommodate group sizes up to about 25 people. Only one unit can rent the building at a time. The rental fee is \$50.00 booking fee plus \$150.00 per night. Contact any-calgaryfacilities@girlguides.ca to discuss your options.

Sleeping Indoors at Camp Mockingbird

Camp Mockingbird is closed for the winter and will re-open on May 1, 2022. Units are welcome to book now for overnight usage in the spring, however, since we don't know what the RIPG rules will be at that time, we will confirm building capacities and rates closer to the date.

Please be aware that the propane tank for Lodge is empty so the propane lights, fridge and stove are not usable. At this time, we don't know when we'll be able to re-fill the tank for Lodge. The tanks for other buildings still have propane.
