- Scholarship can be received only once.
- Reference letters must be dated within 6 months of the application deadline. References from family members will not be accepted.

- Leadership activities (**5 points**)
- Hobbies/Personal Interests (**5 points**)
- Guiding experience (**15 points**)
- Response to statements on Guiding (**10-15 points each**)
- 2 confidential recommendations (either Guiding or outside Guiding references) (**10 points each**)
