These bursaries were established by BC Council to recognize the contributions of active girl members and to offer financial assistance towards education in a field that will enhance the life of the recipient. The Book of Honour Bursary will be awarded to the top candidate in the selections process.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this bursary, the applicant must:

- Be an active member in good standing of Girl Guides of Canada.
- Have been active in BC Guiding for the last three years.
- Be a resident of BC.
- Be a registered grade 12 student at a BC secondary school (independent, home and private schools included).
- Be planning to attend a public or private post-secondary institution (all fields of study are eligible).
- Show a commitment to service in her school and community.

REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The bursary is conditional upon acceptance at the post-secondary institution of the recipient's choice.
- 2. The bursary must be used within 18 months of the date of notification.
- 3. The recipient(s) is encouraged to continue her involvement in Guiding.
- 4. Successful applicants are eligible to receive one, and only one, of the girl scholarships that the BC Awards Committee decides.
