### ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must:

1. Be an active member of Girl Guides of Canada in good standing.
2. Have been active in BC Guiding for the last three years.
3. Be a resident of BC.
4. Be a registered grade 12 student at a BC secondary school (independent, home and private schools included).
5. Be entering into a degree program at a **recognized degree granting university, college or institution in Canada**.
6. Show a commitment to service in her school and community.

### REQUIREMENTS

1. Preference will be given to applicants who have demonstrated strong leadership skills. Additional consideration may be given to applicants planning to enter a field of study in which females are under-represented.
2. This scholarship is conditional upon acceptance at a **recognized degree granting college or institution in Canada** of the recipient's choice.
3. The scholarship must be used within 18 months of the date of notification.
4. Successful applicants are eligible to receive one, and only one, of the girl scholarships that the BC Awards Committee decides.
