MERCI.	Thank You – Merci Silver Thanks Pin A	Presented in consultation with council concerned.	Given to non-members of Guiding and volunteers to show thanks and appreciation.	Up to 1 month
MERCII	Thank You - Merci Gold Thanks Pin	Given by any Guiding member in consultation with council concerned.	Good service to Guiding. This may be awarded to any Guiding member (including youth) and may be given more than once. Letter describing service to Guiding.	Up to 1 month
Approciation	Certificate of Appreciation	Given by any Guiding member.	May be given to any Guiding member (including youth) or any community member, business or organization to show appreciation.	Up to 1 month
TeamWork	Team Award	Area → Province (in consultation)	Extraordinary teamwork for an event or project. Adult or youth members.  Two detailed supporting letters from members not part of the proposed team.	2 – 3 months

GIRL BC BOOK OF WORKER BOOK OF WORK OF W	Book of Honour	Area → Province (in consultation)	Adult or youth member of Guiding who has made a significant contribution to Guiding:  Requires three letters of support, a photo of recipient and a minimum \$100 donation. (Donations support the Bursary of Honour fund)	3 months
See animation by	Provincial Letter of Commendation	Area(for approval) → Province (in consultation)	Adult or youth member who has made significant contributions: One detailed supporting letter	2 months
	Honorary Life Award N	Area → Province → National (in consultation)	Extraordinary member: Three detailed supporting letters plus \$500 (national fee) and approximately \$150 (pin & courier costs) Recipients must comply with GGC conditions of membership/screening.	3 months
FORTITUDE	Fortitude Award	Area → Province → National (in consultation)	Adult or youth member who has endured suffering with courage:  Minimum two detailed supporting letters	3 months
VALOUR	Valour Award Bronze/Silver/Gold	Area → Province → National (in consultation)	Adult or youth member who has risked her life to save another: Minimum two detailed supporting letters. Applications submitted with 12 months after the incident.	3 months
