This education grant was established by BC Trefoil Guild members to commemorate the 100th Birthday of Guiding in Canada. Funds were donated by Trefoil Guilds and individual members throughout BC.

OBJECTIVE

To provide funding to BC members of Girl Guides of Canada age 19-30 years to further their education.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- Donations may be made to the BC Trefoil Guilds' Education Grant.
- Individuals donating will receive a charitable tax receipt (if your donation is less than \$10 the receipt must be requested).
- The value of the grant(s) given each year will be dependent upon the interest earned from the BC Trefoil Guilds' Education Grant Fund. The number and value of grants awarded in a year are at the discretion of the provincial awards committee.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this bursary the applicant must:

- Be 19-30 years of age in the application year.
- Be an active member in good standing of Girl Guides of Canada.
- Have been active in BC Guiding for the last three years.

GUIDELINES

- Grants will be considered for education of all types, including high school equivalency, technical or career programs, and college or university courses at any public or private institutions.
- Current application forms are available from Girl Guides of Canada, BC Council [Scholarships page](#), under the awards section. To be considered, current application forms must be filled out **completely**, with no additional information and **must be submitted by the deadline**. Application forms must be **signed and dated**. The use of incorrect or out of date forms will result in disqualification of the application.
- In some sections of the application form, a maximum number of words are specified to respond. Any additional words will not be considered.
- This grant is conditional upon acceptance at the institution of the recipient's choice.
- This grant will be awarded only when proof of registration (in the form of a receipt for tuition paid), the recipient's Social Insurance Number and a recent headshot photograph of yourself in Guiding uniform, that is in colour and is high-resolution, have been received by the Provincial Awards Committee.
- This education grant must be used within 18 months of the date of notification.
- Successful applicants may receive only one adult bursary, grant or scholarship per year and may not receive the same adult bursary, grant or scholarship more than once.



- Successful grant recipients must agree to be profiled in GGC materials such as news releases, *Canadian Guider* and *Pipeline* articles, and online at www.girlguides.ca or www.bc-girlguides.org in order to help promote Guiding and the bursary, grant and scholarship program.
- Unsuccessful applicants may re-apply.
- Recipient is expected to continue her involvement in Guiding in whatever way possible.
- Each applicant will be notified of the results.
- Formal announcement of recipient(s) will be made at the BC Annual General Meeting and published in *Pipeline*.

APPLICANTS WILL BE EVALUATED IN TERMS OF THE FOLLOWING:

- Involvement in Guiding
- Experiences outside of Guiding
- Additional hobbies, interests and activities
- Employment
- Statement on Guiding
