

# Camp Challenge Ideas



## Individual Challenges

Challenge rewards can be either **coloured cord or beads**.

1. With a buddy, make a shower and use it. **[Yellow Bead]**
2. Prepare and cook a meal on an open fire or camp stove. **[Green Bead]**
3. Make a foil box oven and bake something in it. OR  
Make a buddy burner and cook on it. **[Red Bead]**
4. Assist in designing and making a flag for camp. **[Blue Bead]**
5. Take part in a wide game. **[Pink Bead]**
6. Light and tend a fire using only one match. **[Orange Bead]**
7. Learn and use a new knot in making a gadget and be able to show someone how to do it. **[Light Green Bead]**
8. Know and use the knots for flag raising. **[Purple Bead]**
9. Make an attractive centerpiece for your table, using only materials that can be gathered. Leave wild flowers and plants growing. **[White Bead]**
10. With a buddy burner, make a sundial, rain gage or wind gage. OR  
Point out a constellation in the night sky. **[Navy Bead]**

## Patrol Challenges

1. Help your patrol pitch a tent. Help another patrol if the patrol should ask.
2. Help your patrol to keep your campsite clean and your tent in good order for the duration of camp.
3. With your patrol, invent a patrol name, keeping the camp theme in mind.
4. With your patrol, make up a song about the outdoors or camp, preferable with original music. Perform this song at campfire.
5. Be the first patrol to have lights out and all quiet at night.
6. Be the first patrol to have breakfast dishes done.
7. With your patrol, make up an interesting game, walk or nature activity.
8. Make up a skit that will last 3 to 5 minutes. The last line of the skit must be "And to think I might have missed all this!"
9. As a patrol, design and create a useful camp gadget.
10. Help your patrol strike your tent. Help another patrol if the patrol should ask.

# Guider Training Challenges

Challenge rewards can be **coloured ribbons**.

1. Attach your red challenge cord to a safety pin using an overhead knot and some half hitches. Make a bowline loop to tie on the ribbons you earn.
2. Be aware of the importance of the Promise and Law at camp. See at least seven of the 10 laws practiced. **[White Ribbon]**
3. Help to pitch and strike a tent and know how to maintain it. **[Yellow Ribbon]**
4. Be aware of Health and Safety at camp with regard to the following: **[Blue Ribbon]**
  - a. fires
  - b. proper food storage
  - c. biffies
  - d. dishwashing
  - e. garbage disposal
  - f. practical campsite set up
5. Help build a fire and cook on it. **[Red Ribbon]**
6. Know the knots used for flag raising. **[Purple Ribbon]**
7. Learn something new or interesting about nature at your campsite regarding the following: **[Green Ribbon]**
  - a. a tree
  - b. a plant
  - c. something growing which you should avoid
  - d. a parasitic plant
8. Make up an interesting game, walk, or nature activity for girl. **[Light Blue Ribbon]**
9. Learn a new cooking method and think you could make a meal with it. **[Orange Ribbon]**
10. Restore your soul. Take time to listen, smell, really see and enjoy being outdoors. Tell us some of the pleasing little things you will remember about living outdoors this weekend. **[Pink Ribbon]**
