



CAMP-OUT









The requirements for this award may be completed in a residential camp-out setting in a backyard or in a tent at a campsite.

Award Requirements

Part A	Help plan and participate in a day outdoors that also includes one night away from home. Help with the meal planning.
Part B	Follow a kit list and pack your own gear. Take care of your personal belongings at your camp-out.
Part C	Waterproof a bedroll for carrying.
Part D	<p>Create a Be Prepared plan.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">  Develop a buddy system in your patrol or group. A buddy system helps the group stay together and keep track of each other. Your Guider or a caring adult will help you do this.  If you're in a building, know where the fire exits are in case of fire or any other emergency. Know where the safe meeting place is and discuss why you take a head count in your patrol or group.
Part E	Take part in a duty schedule at your camp-out. Keep your sleeping area clean and dry.
Part F	Participate in a fire drill at your camp-out.
Part G	Discuss safety measures that should be taken at your campsite to prevent injury.

Participate in at least two of the following activities at your camp-out.

-  Hike
-  Adventure game
-  Campfire activities
-  Guides' Own
-  Tell a story or teach a song about the outdoors
-  Another outdoor activity
