NEW BRUNSWICK COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

The New Brunswick Council, Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada, recognizes the importance of continuing education and has designed a Scholarship Program to encourage further education of active, registered members of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada in New Brunswick. The applicants may attend university, community college, technical school or any recognized post secondary private education facility in a fulltime or part time capacity.

A scholarship will be awarded each year in the amount of \$500.00 to assist with the tuition of the successful applicant. Application forms are available from the Provincial Office in Saint John, NB or on the New Brunswick Council website at www.girlguides.nb.ca

Application Process

Applications must be received **no later than March 15** and must be mailed or couriered to:

Faxes and e-mails will not be accepted. Applications must be completed correctly with all required enclosures. Late applications will not be accepted under any circumstances.

Criteria

- Applicants must be well-rounded active members of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada in New Brunswick. The recipient must continue her involvement with Guiding in New Brunswick for at least one year following the use of the scholarship.
- A copy of either High School marks for freshman year or post secondary marks for continuing education is to accompany the application.
- Recipient must provide proof of acceptance at the chosen institution by September 15. A cheque for \$500.00 will be forwarded to that institution to assist with tuition.
- The recipient must allow her name and/or image to be published through the signing of an IR-1form. A current photo must accompany the application.
- Unsuccessful candidates are encouraged to apply again.

Recommendations

Two confidential recommendations from non-family members (one from a Guiding member and one from a non-Guiding individual) in the form of a letter in a sealed envelope must accompany the application. The letter should include how long the writer has known the applicant and in what capacity; qualities of the applicant that make her a deserving recipient, and any other relevant information.
