

Prince Edward Island Area Awards

Gladys M. Pineau Award.

This award is strictly a Prince Edward Island Area Award. It started in 1987.

The recipient will receive a keeper's plaque and a plaque will be placed at the Girl Guide Office in Charlottetown on the Gladys M. Pineau Award Board.

The Criteria needed to receive this award are:

- The recipient must be a Registered Guider in Prince Edward Island Area.
- Must have provided leadership, demonstrate initiative and devotion to Guiding.
- Have exceptional characteristics and outstanding services with Guiding.
- Must complete a form R.3P and provide a minimum of 2 letters of support.

Honourable Marion L. Reid Award.

This award is strictly a Prince Edward Island Area Award. It started in 1994.

This award is an exceptional award. This Award honours Prince Edward Island's first female Lieutenant Governor Marion Reid from North Rustico and her lifelong interest in youth.

The recipient will receive a keeper's plaque and \$100.00 cheque from Girl Guides of Canada, Prince Edward Island Area.

The Criteria needed to receive this award are:

- The recipient must be an active Youth Member (age range 15-17+ years) from Prince Edward Island Area.
- The recipient must have been active in her community in volunteer service and still contributes to her community development.
- The recipient must show her daily living and that she lives by the Guide Promise and Law.
- An award application form R.3P needs to be filled out with a minimum of 2 letters of support – from Guiding.
- Also needed is a letter of support from another volunteer organization.

Oak Leaf Award.

This award is strictly a Prince Edward Island Area Award, it started in 1989.

The Oak Leaf Award is in remembrance of our provincial tree, the Red Oak. It is our only native oak and is now mainly found in Charlottetown, Tracadie and Georgetown areas. In proper conditions it can be a fast growing tree, reaching up to 60ft in height.

The recipient will receive a gold plated broach with her name on it and the exceptional service to Guiding in the Province.

The Criteria needed to receive this award are:

- The recipient must be a current registered adult member on P.E.I.
- The recipient must hold the Medal of Merit Award.
- The recipient must have given *exceptional* service to Guiding in the province.
