DAWN 2019 DISCOVER ADVENTURE WONDER NATURE

Description NL Council Interprovincial Camp - DAWN 2019 will be a large Camp for NL Guides, Pathfinders and Rangers, with participants from provinces within Canada. It will be a true basic camping experience involving tenting and patrol cooking with a program full of challenge and fun. Join us for adventures in water activities, arts, crafts, sports and exploring the western part of our Island situated in spectacular Gros Morne National Park, near the community of Lomond.

Where This camp will be held at Killdevil Campsite, Lomond, NL. Located on the shores of Bonne Bay with stunning ocean views and magnificent mountains, rich in cultural connections.

When

July 29 – August 4, 2019

- Official Camp Opening will be on Monday Evening July 29
- Camp Officially ends on Sunday 4 August

Who

- Eight (8) girls born 2004 2008 and two (2) Adult Guiders
- Four (4) girls born 2001 2003 (Rangers) and one (1) Adult Guiders
- Eight (8) girls born 2001 2003 (Rangers) and two (2) Adult Guiders

Qualifications

- Guiders and girls must be registered Members in Girl Guides of Canada, have completed four nights (need not be consecutive) at camps in tents by July 1, 2019.
- One Adult per patrol must have Standard First Aid.

Fees

Out-of-Province Patrols:

Cost will be \$500.00 per person (includes GST) - \$5,000.00 full patrol, \$2,500.00 \(\frac{1}{2} \) patrol.

NL Patrols

Cost will be \$400.00 per person (includes HST) - \$4000.00 full patrol, \$2000.00 ½ patrol.

Core Staff: No fee for NL members/screened volunteers. \$300.00 for out-of-province applicants.

Payment dates: January 31, March 15 and May 1, 2019 – each payment \$1,666.66 or \$833.33 for ½ patrols. All payments must be made to GGC – NL Council, Interprovincial Camp, 63 Roosevelt Avenue, St. John's, NL A1A 0E8

Out of province participants are responsible for their own travel to and from Deer Lake. NL patrols and Core Crew may avail of transportation arranged by provincial council.



Patrol Adults

These Guiders will be responsible for the girls under their care. Each patrol will become a part of a Sub Camp. Guiders will have plenty of opportunity to spend time with their girls and join them in their activities, but help will be needed on a part-time basis to assist Core Staff. One Guider will be at Program at the same time as the girls, while the other will be assigned to a specific activity. Further information about this will be received along with the girls' activity selection sheets. Patrols of Rangers will be away on an out trip at some point during the camp. Guiders with necessary qualifications may have the chance to take part in an outtrip but otherwise they will remain on site and be assigned duties.

Core Staff

A variety of core staff positions are available in Health & Wellness, Event & Emergency Management, Food Services, Program, Public Relations, Merchandising, Special Events, Sub-camps, Transportation and Site Services.

Registration Process

Following the selection of core crew and patrol, registration will commence in early 2019. Information to follow.
