

## NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR PROVINCIAL RANGER AWARD

### CRITERIA

Girl Guides of Canada–Guides du Canada, Newfoundland and Labrador Council has developed the following criteria to recognize the efforts of an outstanding member of the Organization.

This Award will be given to a girl who:

- has lived in Newfoundland and Labrador for a period of not less than two (2) years
- has been a member of Guiding for at least three (3) years (not necessarily consecutive)
- is currently registered as a Ranger

She is a young woman who:

- exemplifies the Mission of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada in her everyday life.

**Our Mission: To be a catalyst for girls empowering girls.**

- acts as a role model for her peers and younger girls
- actively provides service in her community

The recipient of the Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Ranger Award represents the many young women in Guiding who provide leadership and inspiration to others and who will be the future leaders in their communities and country.

## RANGER AWARD NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

**PLEASE NOTE: DO NOT GIVE THE NOMINATION FORM OR LETTERS TO THE NOMINEE. THE NOMINATION IS CONFIDENTIAL.**

The forms are to be written or typed in **BLACK INK**. They will be photocopied for review by the Selection Committee.

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. THE FORMS REQUIRED FOR THE NOMINATION ARE:

- R.NL-1 **Nomination Form.** To be completed and signed by the Nominating Guider
- R.NL-2 **Confidential Recommendation – Guiding**  
**Two** separate recommendations are required from active members of Canadian Guiding who are not related to the nominee
- R.NL-3 **Confidential Recommendation - Outside Guiding**  
**One** recommendation is required from an adult not presently involved in Canadian Guiding and not related to the nominee.

### **NOTE RE CONFIDENTIAL RECOMMENDATIONS:**

The award criteria is included on the recommendation form. It is important to assure the person giving the reference that any information provided in the recommendation will be kept strictly confidential.

- March 15 - To Provincial Office
- April 5 - To Awards Committee for review
- Award presentation at Provincial Annual General Meeting
