

# Paper Lantern Craft

## for World Thinking Day

#### **Materials**

- Craft Sticks
- Tracing paper
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Markers
- Glue and/or hot glue and glue gun
- LED tealight candle

### **Optional**

- Metallic washi tape
- Trefoil cutout/template



#### Instructions

- 1. Glue four craft sticks together to make one side of the lantern. Repeat this step four times to get each side. If you want to add a base to the lantern, make one more craft stick square.
- 2. Cut out four square pieces of tracing paper. (We used one of our craft stick squares from step 1 as a measure).
- 3. Decorate your four tracing papers. This will be where your light shines through.
- 4. Glue your decorated papers on to each one of your craft stick squares.
- 5. Glue the sides together using a hot glue gun. You can also use regular craft clue but it will take extra time to dry.
- 6. Place an LED tealight candle inside your lantern and you are all set for World Thinking Day.

Optional: Decorate the lantern edges with washi tape or stickers.
