We cannot be prouder of our growth in Membership this year. We ended the 2019-2020 Guiding year with 1650 girls and 417 adult members in Quebec. Our girl membership (Sparks, Brownies, Guides and Pathfinders) went up by 79 girls, exciting – yes! But I am particularly pleased with the increase in our Ranger count this past year... up from 52 to now 70 young women. This represents a strong future for Guiding Leadership in Quebec.

All of your hard work has helped us to grow 5% in membership this year alone! Congratulations and thank you all.

The highlight for the 2019 Guiding year was definitely our Voila Quebec, Inter-Provincial week-long camp at Wa-Thik-Ane. It was attended by girls/patrols from across the country and was represented by every province. This was an enriching opportunity to showcase Quebec's unique culture to our fellow Guiding sisters in Canada. Great Job Team Voila Quebec!

- Girls Participated and represented GGC-QC at countless community events
- Lastly, we had girls camping abroad – to Dawn, Our Cabana, and Go East.
