

What does the SafeGuide Adviser do?

- 1) Monitor the SafeGuide Advisor email regularly, in order to:
 - Stay on top of Communications from the Risk Management team at National (regarding changes in risk assessment policy and procedures)
 - Offer a Quebec perspective on existing policy and any proposed changes, and advocate for French content
 - Keep an eye on ongoing assessments being carried out by the Quebec assessment team, offering added support as needed
- 2) In general as part of the provincial risk assessment team:
 - Be aware of all SafeGuide assessments that are ongoing in the province and assist where possible / necessary. Ensure that assessments are completed in a timely manner.
 - Strategize for handling of assessments that are beyond the current capacity of Quebec's assessment team (e.g. water activities)
 - Be part of the 'assessor rotation', taking on a share of yellow-level activity assessments
 - Assess province-wide events (or delegate/share assessment as needed)
 - Where possible, assess "last-minute events" (where paperwork has arrived <2 weeks before the
 event)
 - Participate in provincial adult events as a SafeGuide resource (e.g., information sessions, training, Q&A)
 - Be a resource and friendly face/voice for SafeGuide questions
 - Recruit assessors
