1930

- 1934, first Provincial Extension Secretary to serve interests of children in hospitals like the Solarium, Children's Hospital, Preventorium. Name was changed to Handicapped and finally now called Girls with Special Needs
- 1935, second visit of Lord and Lady BP
- Development of Camp Olave at Wilson Creek
- 1936, property was purchased at Sooke for a permanent campsite
- 1937, Lord BP's 80th Birthday, celebrated in Vancouver by 250 Guides collecting 60 sacks of rubbish from local beaches - early conservation
- 1939, visit from King George and Queen Elizabeth. Girls in Vernon waited for their arrival standing in relentless rain, getting them so wet it took the dye and the shape from their blue felt hats
- 1938, Provincial Office was moved to Vancouver. Garden parties were held to financially support the office
