

NATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM



GENERAL INFORMATION

The National Scholarship Program is one of the ways that Girl Guides of Canada–Guides du Canada (GGC) recognizes members who embody the Mission and Values of the organization. This program supports members as they pursue their education/training at a recognized post-secondary institution.

General Requirements for all Applicants:

- 1. Applicants must be currently registered members.
- 2. Scholarships are conditional on acceptance or continuation in a full-time or part-time program at a recognized post-secondary institution.
 - Recognized post-secondary institutions include universities, colleges and vocational schools where high school completion is the normal entrance requirement (unless entering as an adult student).
- 3. Scholarship recipients are expected to make reasonable efforts to continue their involvement in Guiding.

SCHOLARSHIP SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS:

Bayer Inc. Science Education National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are pursuing a post-secondary degree with particular emphasis in the field of applied science and technology (including chemistry and physics).

Col. Karen Ritchie Memorial National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their first year of an engineering program.

Dr. Roberta Bondar National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their third or fourth year of an undergraduate degree or postgraduate studies in math, science, applied science or technology.

Norma Osler Education National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are pursuing a post-secondary degree with particular emphasis in the field of education (including teachers' college).

WBE Canada National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are pursuing a postgraduate business degree with a particular emphasis on entrepreneurial studies.

GGC First Year Full-time National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their first year of post-secondary studies. The First Year Full-time National Scholarship includes donations from:

GGC Second Year Full-time National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their second year of post-secondary studies.

GGC Third Year Full-time National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their third year of post-secondary studies.

GGC Fourth Year Full-time National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are entering their fourth year of post-secondary studies.

GGC Postgraduate National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are pursuing a postgraduate degree, diploma or certificate.

GGC Part-time Studies National Scholarship

For registered members of GGC who are pursuing a degree, diploma or certificate on a part-time basis. As per the Canada Student Loans Program, a part-time student is defined as one who is enrolled in 20-59 per cent of a full course load.
