At the Togakushi Girl Scouts Center in Nagano prefecture, where is surrounded by beautiful nature and by the common spirits of girl scouts and girl guides, 150 Japanese girls scouts and 60 international scouts and guides will be gathered.

Date : August 5th to 11th, 2015

Camp : August 7th to 9th, 2015 (3 nights 4 days)

Stay afterward (National Olympic Center) : August 10th, 2015

Place :

Togakushi Girl Scouts Center (in Nagano Prefecture, 5hrs north from Tokyo)

Participants :

150 Japanese scouts aged 13-18 years old

50 Japanese leaders

60 International scouts/guides aged 13-18 years old and leaders

(10 scouts/guides and 2 leaders each from 5 different countries)

Participation Fee :

35,000 to 40,000 JPY (Approx. 350 to 400 USD) *Detail will be informed June 2014

Covered : - programs fees, handbook and all meals during the homestay and camp

- transportation from Narita to homestay house in Saitama, Saitama to
Togakushi, Togakushi to Tokyo, Tokyo to Narita

NOT covered - Transportation from each countries to Japan
